

Sylvan Falls Mill

Description:

This is actually a working grist mill complete with owners who are anxious to share the story of the mill. It was built in 1840 and has operated as a grist mill for over 175 years.



Notes for the photographer:

You can photograph the mill from the roadway but the owners (proprietors of a B&B of the same name) will gladly allow you onto the property if you ask. The shoals in the background of the picture are Sylvan Falls.

Directions: Travel north on Hwy 441. About one mile north of Mountain City turn left onto Wolffork Road (across from Don's Mobil). At 2.2 miles make a left turn onto Taylor's Chapel Rd. The mill is on the right at .2 miles.
